Oh Canada, how we love you!!! I just spent 10 days up North in Waterton Lakes, Banff, Bow Lake, and Fernie and with the exchange rate of \$1.00 US to ~ \$1.40 Canadian Loonie, I couldn't spend money fast enough, eh?

Now you might say, what's this got to do with Wine, to which I say I had many > \$200 meals paired with wine that were out of this world/mind blowing in every regard, but with the ~ 40% discount made them taste even better.

In particular, Banff fancies itself as a World Wide Destination and I won't argue the point. I stayed at the 4 Star Rimrock Lodge Resort across the street from the Banff Hot Springs and was blown away with the view/accommodations/culinary experience.

The Lodge will be closing in September for renovation, but I was able to meet with their Sommelier and talk wine with him to the point where since the Resort would be closing, the wine cellar he had put together needed to get 'drained' and I was more than willing to assist in this endeavor.

What transpired next was the Head Chef/Sommelier pulling together his 'Grand Finale' six course menu of every favorite dish they ever served expertly paired with six wines from the cellar. At \$499/person (Canadian) it was sublime and probably the best meal with paired wine I have ever experienced.

The reason I mention all this is to point out that you never know when opportunity knocks and given that YES Members have a good working knowledge of all things wine, you have the ability to parlay that into meeting new people and talking wine with them to point where they will open up, share what they have and make it truly special.

Bottom line: Get out there and travel to places you've never been. I highly recommend Alberta/British Columbia right next door, yet worlds away given that Alberta Beef is some of the World's best, British Columbia has great wines from the Ovanagn Valley served with a true British Flair, and the people love Americans (although not Trump so much), eh?
