A Taste of Texas

Did you know that Texas is the fifth largest wine production state in the U.S., only behind California, New York, Washington and Oregon and has over 400 wineries? The first wine grapes were planted in 1650 near El Paso by Spanish missionaries, and now Texas has over 4,550 acres of *Vitis Vinifera* grapes.

The wines we will be featuring are all from Texas vineyards produced by **Becker Winery** in Stonewall, Texas, and **Bending Branch Winery** in Comfort, Texas. They will include: 2017 Viognier, 2020 Picpoul Blanc, 2016 Comfortage (Roussanne), 2018 Mourvedre, 2018 Tannat, 2018 Dolcetto, 2016 Grenache, and a 2017 Ranger Hays (Bordeaux Blend). Texas beer will also be available, made by **Spoetzl Brewery** in Shiner, Texas.

The Texas-style BBQ done by Pit Master **John Vandervale** will feature the "Texas Trinity," which is beef brisket, pork ribs and sausage links. Sides will include ranch beans, cole slaw, tortillas and salsa. Dessert will be fruit cobblers.

This "Taste of Texas" will be held on Saturday June 12th starting at 4:00 pm with wine tasting, visiting and Texas music. The BBQ will be served at approximately 5:00 pm. This Saturday event will be held at the home of **Chuck and Julie Johnson** with lots of open space and room to roam. Parking is at a premium, so we ask that, if possible, you consider carpooling with your friends. Please remember to bring a wine glass marked with your identification.

Cost for the evening will be \$50 for members and \$60 for guests. So put on your jeans, cowboy boots, Stetson and grab your partner and prepare yourself for a special "Taste of Texas."
